## Congratulations on winning State Cup!

To have gotten this far, you know that soccer is more than just about scoring goals.

So we've figured out a way to make those goals REALLY count.

**What's the B+ Foundation?** The B+ Foundation was founded in honor of Andrew McDonough, a 14-year-old soccer player who represented Delaware in ODP and at Regionals as a member of the Concord Clash. After playing 4 indoor soccer games, he was diagnosed with Leukemia and never left the hospital. Andrew's blood type was B+, as was his motto in the hospital, and now it's the name of his Foundation - with the goal of finding better pediatric cancer treatments. The B+ Foundation is endorsed by both DYSA and Major League Soccer (MLS).
