DELAWARE YOUTH SOCCER ASSOCIATION ANNOUNCES WINNING THE INNOVATE TO ELEVATE GRANT AWARD FOR 2024 THRU 2026!

THE U.S. SOCCER FEDERATION ANNOUNCED IN THE FALL OF 2023 THAT THE INNOVATE TO ELEVATE GRANT RFP (REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS) WOULD BE RETURNING WITH THE POTENTIAL OF AWARDS UP TO $\$ 100,000$. APPLICATION DEADLINES WERE RIGHT BEFORE THE END OF THE FALL SOCCER SEASON. THE FOCUS AGAIN WAS ON NEW OR EXISTING PROGRAMS THAT WERE FOR OUR AT RISK, INNER-CITY POPULATIONS THAT HAVE LIMITATIONS TO SOCCER PROGRAMS

AS MANY OF YOU ARE AWARE DYSA WAS A RECIPIENT OF 1 OUT OF 20 AWARDS THAT TOOK PLACE DURING THE FALL OF 2020. THE GRANT OF $\$ 5,000$ OPENED THE DOOR FOR DYSA TO TEST INNOVATIVE APPROACHES FOR CREATING A SOCCER ENVIRONMENT FOR AT RISK GIRLS THAT WAS TRULY INCLUSIVE AND SHOWED THAT THERE IS A SAFE PLACE FOR THEM IN THE PERFECT GAME SOCCER. AFTER AN UNSUCCESSFUL SPRING SEASON, WE AT DYSA REALIZED THE PROGRAM NEEDED TO BE DONE DURING AFTER SCHOOL HOURS AND RUN AS AN AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM.

DYSA FORMED A PARTNERSHIP WITH STANTON MIDDLE SCHOOL UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THEIR PRINCIPAL, MATTHEW ROBINSON AND ATHLETIC DIRECTOR, ROBERT BOYD WHO FELT THAT THE DELAWARE GIRLS' SOCCER InITIATIVE BROUGHT MORE TO THE TABLE THAN JUST SOCCER. ROBERT BOYD Stated "THE DELAWARE GIRLS' SOCCER INITIATIVE STRENGTHENS THE GIRLS FOCUS ON BEING PART OF A TEAM, THUS BECOMING A BETTER STUDENT IMRAN KHAN, COACH OF THE DELAWARE GIRLS' INITIATIVE PROVIDES A STRONG FOCUS ON BEING A TEAM PLAYER, EACH PLAYER GIVING $100 \%$ AND TRYING THEIR BEST. WHILE PRACTICES MAY APPEAR TOUGH, THE GIRLS NEVER COMPLAIN AND HOLD COACH K IN HIGH REGARD.

2024 IS BRINGING EVEN MORE EXCITING OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE GIRL'S SOCCER Initiative. We are Currently in talks With the leadership of THE ELKS TO BRING THIS PROGRAM TO TWO ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS IN NEW CASTLE COUNTY. WE HAVE PARTNERED WITH DICK'S SPORTING GOODS TO PROVIDE SOCCER BALLS TO EVERY PLAYER WHO ENROLLS IN THE INITIATIVE. NEW BALANCE IS WORKING WITH US TO PROVIDE THE NECESSARY FOOTWEAR FOR OUR GIRLS.

In addition, delaware youth soccer association, dysa, Will be CONTINUING TO COLLABORATE WITH OUR COMMUNITY PARTNERS, UAFL, AND OUR AREA SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO SOCCER FOR YOUNG GIRLS INTERESTED IN PLAYING THE BEAUTIFUL GAME WHO OTHERWISE WOULD NOT be able to. We at dysa recognize the need for more women coaches IN THE GAME.

DELAWARE YOUTH SOCCER ASSOCIATION AGREES WITH THE U.S. SOCCER FEDERATION ON THE IMPORTANCE OF CHANGE. THE UNITED FOR GIRLS InItiative . . "InNoVATE TO ELEVATE" GRANT IS PAVING THE WAY OF CHANGE FOR GIRLS IN THE FIRST STATE, AND OPENING THE DOORS FOR MORE YOUNG WOMEN TO HAVE THE EXPOSURE TO PLAY SOCCER IN DELAWARE

U.S. SOCCER ANNOUNCED THAT ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPROVED OVER \$3 MILLION IN INNOVATE TO GROW GRANTS TO FUND 27 PROGRAMS BY 25 MEMBER ORGANIZATIONS THAT WILL BENEFIT 762,398 PLAYERS, COACHES AND REFEREES ACROSS THE U.S. SOCCER ECOSYSTEM. THE ANNOUNCEMENT COMES AHEAD OF U.S. SOCCER'S ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING WHiCH WILl TAKE Place in dallas FROM FEB. 8-11.

THIS MARKS THE THIRD CONSECUTIVE YEAR THAT U.S. SOCCER APPROVES ALL budgeted funds for grants. In line with u.s. SOCCER'S STRATEGIC VISION and accelerated initiatives, the grants will help grow the game and FOSTER THE BEST PLAYING ENVIRONMENTS BY FUNDING PROGRAMMING FOCUSED ON INCREASING ACCESSIBILITY AND PARTICIPATION FOR SOCCER IN ALL ITS FORMS AS WELL AS PROVIDING RESOURCES TO INCREASE THE AVAILABILITY OF REFEREE AND COACHING EDUCATION RESOURCES FOR SEVERAL MEMBERS ACROSS THE COUNTRY.
U.S. SOCCER APPROVED $\$ 3,000,165$ TO SUPPORT 27 PROJECTS, EIGHT OF WHICH WILL BE FIRST-TIME INNOVATE TO GROW FUND RECIPIENTS.

THE INNOVATE TO GROW GRANTS WILL DIRECTLY FUND PROGRAMMING TO INCREASE EDUCATION RESOURCES FOR YOUTH COACHES AND REFEREES, REMOVE FINANCIAL BARRIERS OF ENTRY FOR PARTICIPANTS IN MARGINALIZED COMMUNITIES, INCREASE PARTICIPATION OPPORTUNITIES FOR GIRLS AND WOMEN, AND PROVIDE RESOURCES FOR AN ARRAY OF DISABLED SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS TO MAKE SOCCER MORE ACCESSIBLE TO ALL.
recognizing the vital role that federation members play in the GROWTH OF SOCCER IN THE U.S., THE INNOVATE TO GROW FUND WAS ESTABLISHED IN 2017 TO HELP U.S. SOCCER MEMBER ORGANIZATIONS LAUNCH NEW AND INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS DESIGNED TO GROW PARTICIPATION IN THEIR MARKETS. TO BE CONSIDERED FOR GRANT FUNDING, MEMBERS' PROPOSED PROGRAMS MUST MEET CERTAIN CRITERIA AS PART OF A COMPREHENSIVE APPLICATION PROCESS, INCLUDING:

MUST be U.S. SOCCER ORGANIZATION MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING
ONE (1) TO (3) YEAR GRANT DURATION FOR NEW PROGRAMS OR PROGRAMS THAT have been piloted within the last three (3) years and would use itg FUNDS TO SCALE UP AND EXPAND

MEMBER MUST SHOW FINANCIAL INVESTMENT INTO PROGRAM, INCLUDING THEIR OWN FUNDS, OTHER DONOR OR SPONSORSHIP FUNDING, REINVESTING PROGRAM REVENUE, OR IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS

PROGRAM MUST ALIGN WITH U.S. SOCCER PHILOSOPHIES ON PLAYER DEVELOPMENT, COACHING, AND PLAYER SAFETY

MAXIMUM GRANT OF $\$ 200,000$, SUBJECT TO EXCEPTIONS APPROVED BY THE U.S. SOCCER BOARD OF DIRECTORS
